Enrichment Program

Our enrichment program is designed to take place within the classroom setting and is available to all students enrolled in our preschool. Individualized academic instruction is provided for the struggling as well as the advanced student by our enrichment specialist which is in addition to their classroom teachers.

Social Skills Group

Our groups are available to all students enrolled in preschool and it takes place during their school day. These 30-40 minute groups are led by a board certified behavior specialist with the goal of fostering appropriate social behavior.

Play Therapy

Child's Work Counseling Service Inc. provides a play therapy program for an additional \$25.00 per session to all families enrolled in any of Tiny Tots programs and \$30.00 for non-enrolled families. Flexible appointment times.

What is Play Therapy?

Why it can be helpful...

Play therapy is a form of counseling or psychotherapy that uses play to communicate with and help people, especially children, to prevent or resolve psychosocial challenges. This is thought to help them towards better social integration, growth and development, emotional modulation, and trauma resolution.

Children’s Counseling Service:

As a parent, you want what is best for your child, but it’s not always easy to know what type of support he or she needs. Our play therapy program is a good place to turn to when child’s problems seem overwhelming and too difficult to handle alone. Our program can help...

- Increase positive behaviors at home and school
- Strengthen social skills and self esteem
- Develop self-control and manage anger

- Decrease conflict with family members, teachers and peers
- Recover from emotional distress
- Heal from traumatic effects of abuse

Parent Education

Our parent education classes are offered to all parents with children enrolled at Tiny Tots. Classes are offered on a bi-monthly to quarterly basis depending on parent participation. Some fees may be applicable depending on topic.
